

## NOTICE OF 2023 FIREARM TRAINING

As part of the requirement for the completion of the Diploma in Policing qualification this is to inform you that you will be undergoing a practical training for firearm practical training.

The Firearm practical training is COMPULSORY for all students undertaking the Policing program. Therefore, failure to participate will result in non-verification of student's POE at the end of the course and no certificate will be issued. The training will commence from the 25<sup>th</sup> of September to the 2<sup>nd</sup> of October 2023, and will be held for two days per student group.

The cost of the training is as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> year students - **R2, 500.00**

2<sup>nd</sup> year students - **R3,000.00.**

The amount is inclusive of training & Certificate issuance.

Due to the high number of students who will be partaking in the training, compared to the capacity of the training facility, only 15 learners will be accommodated at a time hence, there will be 3 groups of students for the stipulated training days.

Student training groups breakdown is as per the following dates;

1. Group 1 handgun x15 learners 25 to 26 September 2023
2. Group 2 handgun x15 learners 27 to 28 September 2023
3. Group 3 self-loading rifle x9 learners 02 to 03 October 2023.
4. Friday 29 September will be for rewriting of both groups if any student has failed theory training

*NB: Only students who are studying online/part time will be offered a chance to choose dates suitable for them*

### **TERMS & CONDITIONS OF THE TRAINING**

1. Students will be grouped accordingly; confirmation of group date will be sent via sms.
2. Students must please bring along a certified copy of their identity document with them.
3. Students that will undergo rifle training must bring a copy of their handgun training certificate with legal test.
4. Pregnant students will only be allowed to take the theoretical training.
5. Training times - Registration of learners will be by 08h00 while the training will commence by 08h30.
6. Food will not be provided.
7. Information about the cost of transportation will be made available in due time.
